

HON'BLE JUDGES LIBRARY, RAJASTHAN HIGH COURT, JODHPUR

Overview of library

After the inauguration of Rajasthan High Court on 29th August, 1949, at old building the Hon'ble Judges Library, Rajasthan High Court, Jodhpur came into existence.

The new chapter in the history of Rajasthan scripted with the inauguration of the iconic building of Rajasthan High Court On 7th December, 2019 at Jhalamand, Jodhpur. The Judges Library in new building is situated centrally with all modern amenities. Compactors are installed for book storage. This well equipped library is a grid of Libraries

which includes all Court Chambers and Hon'ble Judges residence Library. The High Court Judges Library caters the needs of the Hon'ble Judges and Legal Fraternity.

The Judges Library has a wide collection of Law Journals, Commentaries, Legal Books, General Books, Foreign Journal, Law Dictionaries, General Dictionaries, Medical Dictionaries, Bibliography, Encyclopedia, Reference Books, Law Commission Reports, India Gazette, Rajasthan Gazette, Government Publications, Digest of Law Journals, Central & State Acts/Rules, State Service Rule, State Codes, Manuals of Central & State Enactments, Legal Database/ Online Resources & in house activities. In addition to Central Library, it also maintains all 22 Court Rooms Libraries and Residential Libraries at the residence offices of all the sitting Judges. It is managed by a team of skilled staff to fulfill the information needed by the Hon'ble Judges and Officers of the Court by offering a wide range of services through legal resources and subscribed on-line legal Journals. It subscribes about 55 Indian journals including 1 Foreign Journal and 4 online database.

The Library has strength of 16 staff including a Senior Librarian, Librarian, Assistant Librarian, Cataloger cum Classifier, Reference assistant, Library restorer and supporting staff. Library Restorers are also deputed in Courts during Court Proceedings to provide the cited books and other materials to Hon'ble Judges at the time of hearing in the Courts. The

Judges Library works under the guidance of the Library Committee. The Library Committee, consists of three Hon'ble Judges. It has been constituted by the Hon'ble Chief Justice for supervision & consideration of the matters viz. selection & purchase of new books, journals and all other matters related to the Library.
