In continuation of this office Circular P.I. No. 12/2015 dated 15.12.2015, I am to inform that the matter with regard to increasing arrears of cases in the Subordinate Courts has been viewed seriously by the Hon'ble Apex Court. The matter was considered by the Hon'ble Arrear Committee and as per the Resolution, you are directed :-

1. to effectively monitor and ensure the compliance of the directions issued vide P.I. No. 12/2015 dated 15.12.2015 and send the monthly statistical information regarding disposal of more than five years old cases without failure.
2. the appeals pending in the matters of more than five years old cases be disposed of expeditiously & such cases be personally monitored by the concerned judicial officer.
3. District & Sessions Judges are directed to prepare a list of cases which are held up due to pendency of appeal/revision in the Subordinate Court/High Court and apprise the same to this office at the end of every quarter of the year in the enclosed proforma.

Therefore, it is enjoined upon you to ensure the compliance of the above directions.
