## WRITTEN TEST FOR RECRUITMENT TO THE POST OF TRANSLATOR, 2020

## **INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES:**

- 1. The candidates shall bring the Admit Card downloaded from official website of this Court with them for appearing in the examination. It may be noted that the candidate, who does not possess the Admission Card, would not be allowed to appear in the examination.
- 2. Apart from the admission card, every Candidate must bring with him the followings
  - a. One of the original Photo Identity Proof along with its Xerox Copy (Adhar Card/Driving Licence/Voter ID card/Passport/ Pan Card);
  - b. A recent coloured photograph in the size of 2.5cm x 2.5cm.
- Candidates may bring their Personal 50 ml Hand Sanitizer bottle and Personal Pre-packed transparent water bottle.
- Mobile Phone, Bluetooth, Smart Watch, Calculator, Pager or any kind of Electronic/Communication Device, slide rule, geometry box, wallet, Purse, Bag etc. shall not be permitted within the precincts of Examination Centre.
- 5. Every candidate shall wear face mask. Fresh face mask shall be provided at the centre. The candidate shall remove the mask worn by him/her from home and wear the fresh face mask provided at centre.
- 6. Candidates shall reach the examination centre well in time. They may be allowed to enter into the examination centre 45 minutes before the scheduled time of commencement of examination.
- Every Candidate must ensure that he/she sits on the seat specified for him/her by verifying the Roll Number appearing on the seat with his/her Admission Card.
- 8. As a precaution of COVID-19, hands of the candidates shall be sanitized at the entrance. The candidates shall not make any assembly and keep social distancing as per the guidelines issued by Central & State Government.
- 9. Four (4) types of bell will be rung during the process of examination paper i.e.
  A. Distribution Bell 5 minutes prior to commencement of paper,
  - B. Commencement Bell on scheduled time of commencement of paper,

**C. Warning Bell** - 10 minutes prior to scheduled time for conclusion of the paper and

D. Conclusion Bell – on scheduled time for conclusion of the paper.

- 10. Answer Booklets will be distributed 5 minutes before the schedule time i.e on Distribution Bell and Candidates are advised to properly check the booklets and in case of torn booklet, get replaced the same from invigilators and thereafter, write their respective Roll number and other information as required on the flap of the Answer Book.
- 11. Candidates are directed not to write his/her name and Roll Number on any other part of Answer Booklet and do not enter any sign or initial or mark or word to indicate his / her identity.
- 12. Question paper will be distributed when commencement bell rings on scheduled time of commencement of the paper. Before writing the answers, the Candidates must ensure that they have properly filled in all the required information such as Roll Numbers, Subject etc. on the Answer Booklet in the relevant and specified space.
- 13. Do not use the colour of Ink, other than one used in the beginning on any page of the answer booklet, the answer shall be written in blue or black shade (ink) only. Write all the answers in the same colour of ink.
- 14. Candidates shall write answers in a legible handwriting. No marks will be assigned to answer, which cannot be assessed by the examiners owing to illegible handwriting. No supplementary Answer sheet shall be issued to any of the candidates.
- 15. Do not tear or temper the Answer Booklet, in any manner.
- 16. Exchange of writing material, stencils, etc. is strictly prohibited.
- 17. Late comers may be allowed to enter at the discretion of Nodal Officer & the Centre Superintendent, on being satisfied with the reason(s) expressed by the candidate for delay. No candidate will be allowed the entry beyond 15 minutes after the commencement of the paper.
- 18. Request for change of Examination Centre shall not be entertained under any circumstances.
- 19. Candidate, who wishes to leave the examination hall before the scheduled time, would be allowed to do so only 30 minutes prior to the completion of examination, but he/she will not be allowed to carry Question Paper with him/her.
- 20. There will be a warning bell 10 minutes before the conclusion of the examination. At the conclusion bell, candidates must stop writing and be ready to hand over the Answer Booklet to the invigilator. Candidates must not leave his/ her seat until all the Answer Booklets are collected by the invigilator.

- 21. On completion of the examination, don't get up from your seat until advised by invigilator. The candidates will be permitted to move out one by one, keeping social distancing.
- 22. The Candidate, who disobeys the instructions issued by the Nodal Officer(s) or who is guilty of rude or disobedient behavior, is liable to be instantly expelled from the examination room/ hall.
- 23. Candidates violating these instructions will be debarred from the examination and may also be subject to panel action.
- 24. No T.A. & D.A. shall be admissible to the candidates for appearing in the examination.

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
