**INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES:**

1. Candidates are required to download their respective Admit Card by login at <http://www.hcraj.nic.in> by entering their respective Application ID, Date of Birth & Capcha Code.
2. The candidates shall bring the above downloaded Admit Card with them for the examination. It may be noted that the candidate, who does not possess the Admission Card, would not be allowed to appear for the examination.
3. Entry gate of examination centre for candidates will be open **One Hour before the scheduled time** and candidates may be allowed to enter upto scheduled time. Question Paper cum Answer Booklet will be distributed 5 minutes before the schedule time i.e on first bell and Seal of the Question Paper cum Answer Booklet will be opened on second bell.
4. Late comers may be allowed to enter at the discretion of Nodal Officer & the Centre Superintendent, on being satisfied with the reason expressed by the candidate for delay, but **no candidate will be allowed to enter beyond 15 minutes after the commencement of the examination.**
5. Every Candidate must bring with him **one of the original Photo Identity Proof along with its Xerox Copy (Adhar Card/Driving Licence/ Voter ID card/ Passport/Pan Card)**, a recent coloured photograph in the size of 2.5cm x 2.5cm.
6. **Every Candidate must ensure that he/she sits on the seat specified for him/her by verifying the Roll Number appearing on the seat with his/her Admission Card.**
7. **Request for change of Examination Centre shall not be entertained under any circumstances.**
8. **The Candidates must ensure that they have properly filled in all the required information such as Roll Numbers, etc. on the** Question Paper cum Answer Booklet in the relevant and specified space.

9. The candidate **shall have to sign the certificate of his genuineness** as specified in the Question Paper cum Answer Booklet.
10. Candidate, who wishes to leave the examination hall before the scheduled time, would be allowed to do so only 30 minutes prior to the end of examination.
11. No T.A. & D.A. shall be admissible to the candidates for appearing in the examination.
12. Mobile Phone, Blue-tooth, Smart Watch, Calculator, Pager or any kind of Electronic/ Communication Device, slide rule, geometry box, wallet, Purse, Bag etc. shall not be permitted within the precincts of Examination Centre.
13. Candidates are directed not to write his/her name and Roll Number on any other part of Question Paper cum Answer Booklet and do not enter any signs or initials or marks or words to indicate his / her identity.
14. Do not use the colour of Ink, other than one used in the beginning on any page of the answer, the answer shall be written in blue or black shade (ink) only. **Write all the answers in the same colour of ink.**
15. Candidates shall write answers in a legible handwriting. No marks will be assigned to answer, which cannot be assessed by the examiners owing to illegible handwriting.
16. Do not torn or temper the Question Paper cum Answer Booklet, in any manner.
17. Exchange of writing material, stencils, etc. is strictly prohibited.
18. There will be a warning bell 10 minutes before the conclusion the examination. At the second bell, candidates must stop writing and be ready to hand over the Question Paper cum Answer Booklet to the invigilator. Candidates must not leave his/ her seat until all the Question Paper cum Answer Booklets are collected by the invigilator.
19. Before handing over the Question Paper cum Answer Booklet, make sure that the Roll Number and other particulars on the cover page are correctly filled in.
20. The Candidate, who disobeys the instructions issued by the Nodal Officer(s) or who is guilty of rude or disobedient behaviour, is liable to be instantly expelled from the examination room/ hall.
21. Candidates violating these instructions will be debarred from the examination and may also be subject to panel action.
